

Winter Linseed Bulletin

GROWTH STAGE

Crops across the country are now in flower. Early drilled winter linseed crops are now heading towards the end of flowering and seed capsules are beginning form. Later drilled crops are coming into flower.

LATE FLOWERING FUNGICIDE

With the recent mixed weather and a continued outlook of further mixed weather means that a later flowering fungicide should be used to protect against pod fill from Botrytis and Pasmo (Septoria Linicola). This late flowering application should be made even where a robust fungicide was deployed earlier in the season.

A suitable product would be:

Product	Rate	Notes
Folicur	.75l/ha	At the end of flowering

Ensure annual maximum rates of tebuconazole are not exceeded

DO YOU GROW OILSEED RAPE?

Grow oilseed rape with a minimum of £280mt ex farm.
