



# Canary Seed Bulletin

Spray off any weed or volunteers a day BEFORE planting Canary Seed. **Pre-Planting** 

**Planting Date** Normally mid-March to late April, when soil is warming.

Seed Bed Should be moist, fine, firm, yet not compacted. Light rolling after planting is usually beneficial to

give good seed/soil contact.

Seed Rate 35 kg/hectare – Canary Seed is about the size of Linseed but fatter.

Sowing Depth Depends on if Avadex herbicide is to be used (see below)

Where no Avadex to be used sow between 1.5 – 3.0 cm deep of settled soil (after rolling) into moisture.

Where Avadex is to be used sow between 2.5 – 4.0 cm deep of settled soil (after rolling) into moisture.

Fertiliser

Canary Seed has a low demand for fertiliser. Sulphur and Nitrogen can be applied once the crop is up, but P and K should be applied to the seedbed as follows:

Soil Index	Р	K
0	50	50
1	25	25
2	0	0

#### Nitrogen

Nitrogen can be applied and incorporated into the seedbed, after drilling or after crop emergence as convenient.

Demand is low, but for index 0 situations (following a straw crop and with no recent organic manures) 60 kg/ha is adequate.

If the farm has known Sulphur deficiency this needs to be corrected.

#### Pre-Emergence Weed Control

For grassweed control (eg Wild Oats & Blackgrass) and also to sensitise broadleaved weeds apply Avadex Excel 15 g to the seedbed.

This granular product needs to be applied by a contractor (refer to your agrochemical supplier for

local contractors).

This is the only product available for grassweed control in Canary Seed

#### DO NOT MISS IT IF YOU KNOW YOU HAVE A GRASSWEED PROBLEM!

Avadex Excel 15 g can be applied in either of two ways:

- A) incorporated a few days before planting, or
- B) as a surface application after planting.

### **Incorporated Pre-Sowing**

Product	Rate of Use	Time	Notes
Avadex Excel 15 g	15 kg/ha	Up to 7 days before planting	Incorporate immediately by shallow harrowing  The drilling itself acts as a second incorporation

## Post-Drilling, Pre-emergence of Crop and Weeds

Product	Rate of Use	Time	Notes
Avadex Excel 15 g	15 kg/ha	After drilling/before crop emergence	This application relies on adequate soil moisture for activation
			For best results apply immediately after drilling
